Our rights of way are one of our most precious assets, hidden in plain sight, and often taken for granted. They allow everyone to enjoy the countryside, both on our doorstep and across Cumbria's iconic landscapes.

- Rights of way 'furniture', including finger posts, direction discs, bridges, gates, stiles and path surfaces – who is responsible for their repair and maintenance?
- Who can town and parish councils contact for advice and assistance?
