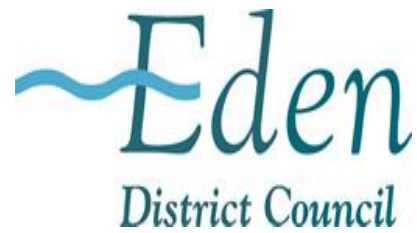

Tree workshop

Not all trees pose safety risks but the recent 'Witley parish council v Cavanagh' court case has highlighted the need to manage more effectively any trees growing on council owned land near to roads, bus stops and children's play areas.

To help Eden's parishes understand what they need to do to manage and maintain their trees, EALC is offering a tree workshop that will:

- clarify the learning points from the court case
- enable councils to identify and prioritise those trees on council-owned land that could create risks
- identify how to source tree surveyors and tree contractors and secure value-for-money price quotations
- consider tree maintenance plans
- outline when tree preservation orders are appropriate
- explain why every parish council should have a risk policy, risk assessment and adequate insurance that is reviewed annually
