

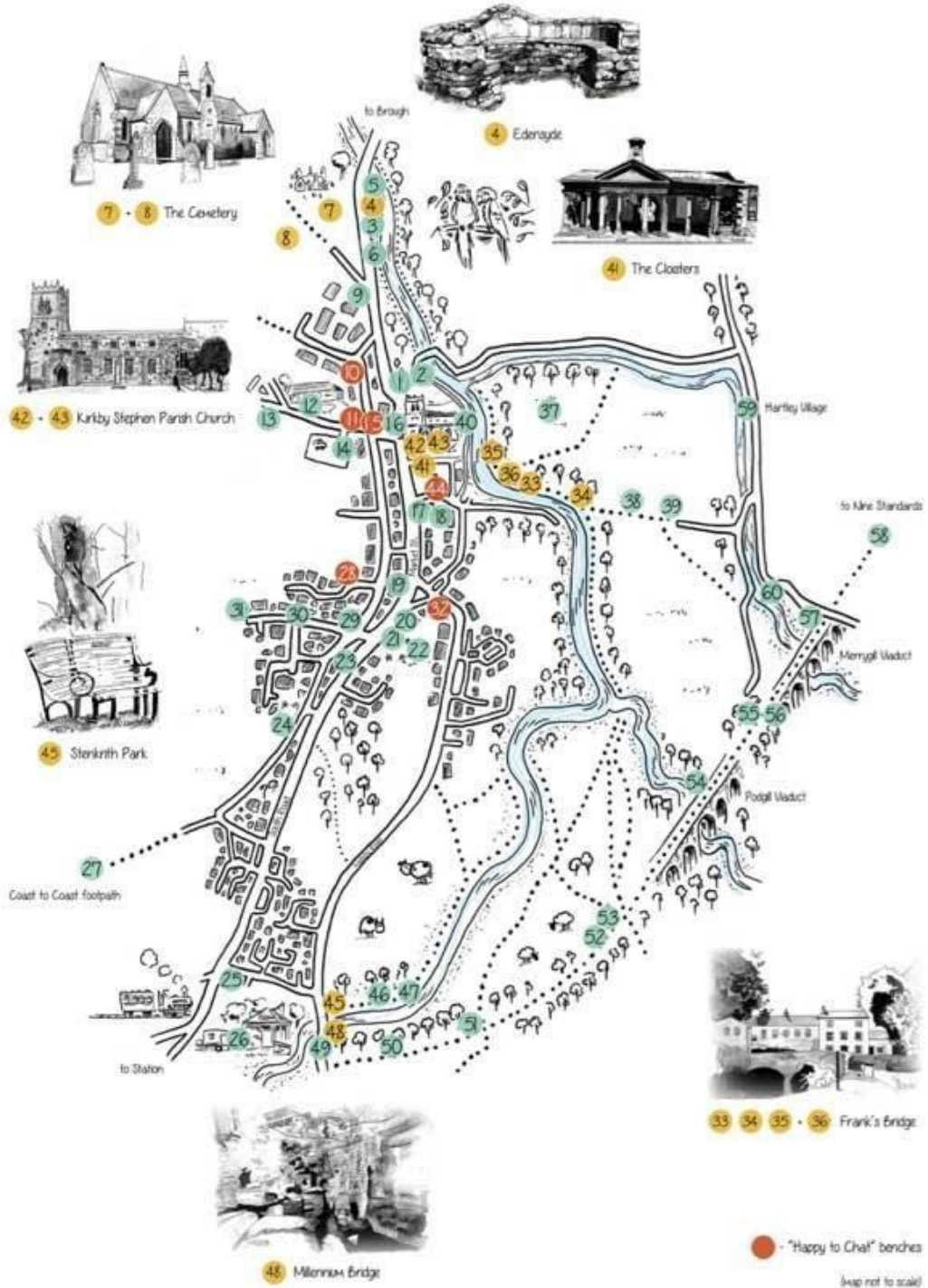

Kirkby Stephen Bench Walks leaflet provides mapped routes in and around Kirkby Stephen town with all the benches clearly numbered on the map.

- The map offers accessible routes for residents, visitors, families with young children in buggies and wheelchair users to explore most of our town.

- The mapped benches provide confidence of being able to walk a short distance with the knowledge of the next essential 'bench' resting place as needed.

- 'Happy to Chat' benches provide somewhere to stop for a chat or conversation if out walking alone.

The design of the Kirkby Stephen Bench Walks has been led by Nalaby and Wharton Ltd and Kirkby Stephen & District Walkers Are Welcome.
